During the calendar year 2019, IPAOM received a total of 25 papers, out of which 5 articles were rejected in the preliminary screening due to plagiarism or being out of the format and peer review process. During 2019 around 20 articles were subjected for publication after they are accepted in the peer review process. In the 6 issues of Volume 11 published during the year 2019, a total of 20 articles were published (at an average of 3-4 articles per issue) of which, articles were

published from authors all around the world. Average publication lag time of an article was further reduced to 2-3 weeks [2].
